Things businesses can do to reduce the impact on our planet:



Commission a carbon footprint assessment



Implement a circular business model/supply chain

Consider the impact on nature of every decision you take



Incentivise employees to make planet friendly choices - eg cycle to work / extra day off for holiday by train (climateperks.com) / plant-based canteen

Things individuals can do to boost nature:

- 1.** Make your garden nature friendly 
- 2.** Ditch the chemicals
- 3.** Don't use biological cleaners/laundry liquids that get into our water system 
- 4.** Avoid man-made fabrics that shed microfibres
- 5.** Join a group planting trees or hedging plants 
- 6.** Get involved in citizen science activities – e.g. bird watch / counting butterflies / river water sampling 
- 7.** Don't waste water
- 8.** Put a swift box put under your eaves (if suitable) 
- 9.** Choose foods with low impact on the planet (eg plant-based, watch out for foods containing palm oil) 
- 10.** Use less plastic
- 11.** Install a water butt
- 12.** Create green corridors for wildlife 

Things councils can do to help us boost nature and cut carbon footprint in Henley:

ENERGY



- More renewable energy schemes (hydro, solar streets, community solar)
- Promote insulation support schemes - eg Welcome the Warmth
- Thermal imaging of thermal leaks in Henley's houses
- Set target for insulating Henley's homes

PUBLIC ENGAGEMENT



- Public information campaign on carbon footprint / boosting nature

FOOD



- Support campaign to encourage a reduction of meat/fish/dairy
- Plant-based catering at council events / any animal products from local organic providers

NATURE



- Declare ecological emergency
- Draw up ecological action plan
- End use of glyphosate and other insect-killing weed killers
- Scale up tree cover
- Rewild sections of council-owned land / create green corridors
- Promote "No Mow May" more heavily / extend duration?

TRANSPORT



- Monthly Bike Morning (regular street closure)
- Instal e-bike chargers
- More cycle routes in area

ADAPTATION



- Install drinking fountains

WASTE



- Declare Henley a waste-free town
- Repair café
- Library of things
