## "By 2025....all education settings will have nominated a sustainability lead and put in place a climate action plan"

#### The Greener Henley Schools Action Network has two key objectives:

- 1. To raise awareness and encourage action within our local school communities
- **2.** To actively collaborate with local schools to provide support / guidance in creating climate and nature action plans by 2025.

We held <u>an event</u> in November 2023, which saw participation from 17 local schools, with some 90 teachers and students (primary and secondary), including 5 headteachers. The event was designed to assist schools in starting to pull together their climate and nature action plans.
